**South of W Las Flores Ave
North of W Ridgecrest Blvd
East of N Alvord St
West of N China Lake Blvd**

We have identified areas that are most at risk in the event of stormwater collection failures. The area indicated above has a higher risk of flooding and area residents are advised to take precautionary measures in the event evacuation may be necessary.

1. Have a bag/suitcase/backpack ready containing a change of clothes and any necessary medications.
2. Make plans with relatives and friends to handle any animal needs.
3. Be ready to leave your house within 30 minutes upon receipt of evacuation advisement.

At this time, this is only precautionary. It is better to be prepared than scrambling at the last minute. We will be continuing to update you when more information is known or the risk level becomes more elevated.
