

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18 TO REQUIRE DISPLAY OF DEALER REGISTRATION CARDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10 of Ordinance No. 18, as amended by Ordinance No. 66, is further amended to read as follows:

"Section 10. The term DEALER as used in this ordinance shall mean a management employee or agent who is dealing all hands in a game and who is not otherwise participating therein. Each such dealer is required to register with the Chief of Police and to pay a \$3.00 fee upon registration for the expense involved in obtaining fingerprints.

"The Chief of Police shall issue a registration card to each person approved to deal cards. Such card shall contain a recent photograph of the approved dealer provided at the expense of the dealer.

"The Chief of Police shall require each approved dealer to display his registration card in a conspicuous place near the table at which he is dealing, plainly visible and legible to players and visitors alike, while he is dealing."

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.






