

ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
CONTROLLING ANIMAL AND OTHER NUISANCES

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:


1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation owning, possessing or controlling any dog, cat or any other animal, fowl, reptile or pet of any kind to permit the pen, cage, yard or other facilities in which it is kept and maintained to accumulate droppings, food, garbage, refuse or any other matter so as to cause flies, odors or other noxious or unsanitary conditions to exist.

2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).


3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it to be published as required by law.


