

ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST  
PROHIBITING OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON  
PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT ADEQUATE MUFFLER

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every person operating on private property other than his own any registered or unregistered vehicle which is self-propelled by its own motor or engine, including 2, 3 or 4 wheeled vehicles, and including but not limited to motorcycles, motor-driven cycles, motor bikes, dirt bikes, dune buggies and similar vehicles, without an adequate muffler to prevent excessive or unusual noise, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Every person who causes or knowingly permits his child, ward or employee under the age of 21 years to operate any vehicle in violation of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to punishment by a fine not in excess of \$100.00, or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
