

ORDINANCE OF CITY OF RIDGECREST
GOVERNING THE STANDING OR PARKING
OF VEHICLES IN PUBLIC STREETS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall stand or park a vehicle in
a public street or highway except as follows:

(a.) If marked or designated for parallel parking,
then parallel with the edge of the roadway headed in the di-
rection of traffic, with the right hand wheels of the vehicle
within eighteen (18) inches of the edge of the curb or roadway,
and within a parking space marked by white lines or other desig-
nation, except that motor-cycles shall be parked with at least
one wheel or fender touching the right hand curb.

(b.) If marked or designated for angle parking, then
at the angle indicated by the white lines or other designation,
with the front wheel closest to the curb or edge of the roadway
touching such edge or curb, and within the parking space marked
by white lines or other designation.

(c.) Commercial vehicles shall comply with the provisions
of subdivisions (a) and (b) except insofar as any variation is
reasonably necessary to accomplish the loading or unloading of
merchandise or passengers, and as long as such stopping or park-
ing is in the direction of travel upon that half of the roadway
on which the vehicle is stopped or parked.

(d.) Unless otherwise permitted by law or appropriate
signs, markings or designations, then only in accordance there-
with.

Section 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be an in-
fraction and any person guilty thereof shall be subject to punish-
ment of a fine not in excess of \$100.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately as
an urgency ordinance based on the following facts: parking in
certain areas of the City of Ridgecrest has created a hazard to
the health, safety and welfare of the community and it is neces-
sary to provide immediate regulation for the protection of the public.





