

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 71 ADOPTING
BY REFERENCE THE 1971 EDITION OF THE
NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 71 of the City of
Ridgecrest is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That certain documents, three (3) copies of each
of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of
Ridgecrest, being marked and designated, 'National Electrical Code,
1971 Edition, prepared and published by the National Fire Protection
Association,' and the 'Uniform Wiring Code, 1965 Edition, prepared
and published by the Southern California Chapter, the International
Association of Electrical Inspectors, 'be and the same are hereby
adopted as the electrical code for the City of Ridgecrest for the
protection of the public health and safety, and requiring a permit
for the installation, arrangement, alteration, and repair of electric
wiring, connections, fixtures, and appliances, placing responsibility
for enforcement in the Building Official, establishing minimum regu-
lations and operation of electric wiring, connections, fixtures, and
other electrical appliances on premises within the City of Ridgecrest,
providing penalties for violations of this code, and each and all of
the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of such
'National Electrical Code, 1971 Edition, 'and Uniform Wiring Code,
1965 Edition, 'on file in the office of the City Clerk are hereby
referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in
this ordinance."

Section 2. Ordinance No. 96 of the City Council of the City
of Ridgecrest is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in the manner
required by law.


