

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST  
PROVIDING FOR THE DEPOSIT IN A  
BANK OF MUNICIPAL FUNDS  
AND WITHDRAWAL THEREOF

The City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Bank of America, N. T. S. A., Ridgecrest Branch, Ridgecrest, California, is hereby designated as the depository of all funds and money coming into the possession of the treasury of the City of Ridgecrest and all such funds and money shall forthwith upon receipt by the City of Ridgecrest be deposited therein to the credit of the City of Ridgecrest.

SECTION 2. All withdrawals upon funds and moneys deposited as required by Section 1 of this ordinance shall be made upon warrants drawn on the City Treasury signed by the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Ridgecrest.

SECTION 3. The City Council may by resolution specify the creation of City funds from time to time as deemed necessary, upon which warrants may be drawn.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and the facts constituting the urgency are declared as follows: That the City of Ridgecrest has become recently incorporated and it is essential to the public welfare and the conduct of the affairs of said city that all public funds be placed in a regular bank for the protection and preservation of such funds.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately and the City Clerk shall cause the same to be published or posted in the manner required by law.
