

ORDINANCE NUMBER 31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST,  
CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN SPEED  
ZONES WITHIN SAID CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A speed limit of 45 miles per hour is hereby  
established upon that certain street known as Randsburg  
Road between the intersection of Allen Street and a point  
400 yards South of the intersection of Bowman Road and  
Randsburg Road.

SECTION 2. A speed limit of 35 miles per hour is hereby  
established upon that certain street known as Randsburg  
Road between a point 400 yards south of Bowman Road and the  
existing 35 mile per hour speed zone on Randsburg Road  
commencing at China Lake Boulevard.

SECTION 3. These speed limits shall become effective upon  
the posting and erection of the necessary speed limit signs  
as required under the Vehicle Code of the State of California.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgency  
ordinance and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.  
The facts constituting the urgency are that it is necessary  
for the safety and welfare of the citizens of Ridgecrest  
that adequate and proper speed limits be established upon  
streets within said City as soon as possible.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk is instructed to publish this  
ordinance as required by law and certify to the passage of


