

ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
REGULATING RECKLESS DRIVING
UPON PRIVATE PROPERTY

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Any person who drives any vehicle upon any private street or other private property within the City Limits of the City of Ridgecrest in willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as an urgency ordinance pursuant to the provisions of Section 36937 of the Government Code of the State of California. The facts upon which the urgency is based are as follows: Certain persons have been guilty of reckless driving of vehicles upon private property within the City of Ridgecrest. We are presently without an Ordinance governing and controlling such activity. It is imperative for the health and safety of the citizens of Ridgecrest that this Ordinance take effect immediately in order to control the activities prohibited by this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in the manner provided by law.


