

ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
EXTENDING INTERIM ZONING TO AND INCLUDING
MARCH 3, 1968

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Interim Zoning Ordinance of the City of Ridgecrest is hereby continued in effect to and including March 3, 1968. Said Ordinance was previously extended to and including March 3, 1967 by the provisions of Ordinance No. 56.

Section 2. The City of Ridgecrest is continuing to conduct studies relative to the adoption of a precise zoning ordinance and this interim zoning ordinance is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare pending the adoption of precise zoning by prohibiting certain uses which may be in conflict with the provisions of said interim zoning ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance is for the protection of public health, safety and welfare and shall take effect immediately as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Section 36937 of the Government Code of California. The facts constituting the urgency are set forth in Section 2 hereof, and in addition, the adoption of this ordinance in the regular manner would result in having no zoning ordinance in effect for a period of approximately 30 days.


Section 4. The City Clerk is instructed to certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and to cause the same to be published or posted in the manner required by law.


