

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST AMENDING ORDINANCE
NUMBER 51 TO ADD THE ADOPTION BY REFER-
ENCE OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE,
1965 EDITION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 51 of the
City of Ridgecrest is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That certain documents, three (3) copies
of each of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk
of the City of Ridgecrest, being marked and designated,
"National Electrical Code, 1965 Edition, prepared and pub-
lished by the National Fire Protection Association," the
"Uniform Wiring Code, 1965 Edition, prepared and published
by the Southern California Chapter of the International
Association of Electrical Inspectors," and the "Electrical
Safety Orders, 1962 Edition, printed by the California State
Printing Office," be and the same are hereby adopted as the
electrical code for the City of Ridgecrest for the protec-
tion of the public health and safety, and requiring a permit
for the installation, arrangement, alteration, and repair of
electric wiring, connections, fixtures, and appliances,
placing responsibility for enforcement in the Building Offi-
cial, establishing minimum regulations and operation of
electric wiring, connections, fixtures, and other electrical
appliances on premises within the City of Ridgecrest, pro-
viding penalties for violations of this code, and each and
all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions,
and terms of such "National Electrical Code, 1965 Edition,"
"Uniform Wiring Code, 1965 Edition," and "Electrical Safety
Orders, 1962 Edition," on file in the office of the City
Clerk are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof
as if fully set out in this ordinance."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately
as an urgency ordinance; the facts constituting the urgency
are that it is necessary that the National Electrical Code
be part of the City's electrical code in order to protect the
public health, safety, and welfare.


Section . This Ordinance shall be published in the manner required by law.


