

ORDINANCE NO. 73

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF RIDGECREST AMENDING ORDINANCE  
NO. 49 ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1967  
EDITION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE,  
VOLUME I

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 49 of the City of  
Ridgecrest is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of  
which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City  
of Ridgecrest; being marked and designated as "Uniform Building  
Code, 1967 Edition, Volume I, published by the International  
Conference of Building Officials," with appendices, be and the  
same is hereby adopted as the building code of the City of Ridge-  
crest for regulating the erection, construction, enlargement,  
alteration, repair, moving, removal, demolition, conversion,  
occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of all  
buildings and/or structures in the City of Ridgecrest; providing  
for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor;  
providing penalties for violation of such code; and each and all  
of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms  
of such "Uniform Building Code, 1967 Edition, Volume I, published  
by the International Conference of Building Officials," with  
appendices, on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby  
referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set out  
in this ordinance."

2. That section 2 of Ordinance No. 49 is hereby amended to  
read as follows:

"Section s. All of Chapter 70 consisting of Sections 7001  
to 7020, both inclusive, of the Uniform Building Code, 1967 Edi-  
tion, Volume I, is hereby deleted."

3. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 49 is hereby amended  
to read as follows:

"Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or  
corporation to erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move,  
improve, remove, convert or demolish, equip, use, occupy or  
maintain any building or structure in said city, or cause the  
same to be done, contrary to or in violation of any of the pro-  
visions of this Ordinance or the Codes adopted herein.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any  
of the provisions of this Ordinance or of the Codes adopted herein

shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each person, firm or corporation shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each day during any portion of which any violation of any provisions of this Ordinance or said Codes is committed, continued or permitted by such person, firm or corporation and shall be punishable therefor as provided by this Ordinance."


4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.
