

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST AMENDING SECTION 201
OF ORDINANCE NO. 79 TO PROVIDE FOR STUB
STREET BARRIERS AND STREET LIGHTING

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 201 of Ordinance No. 79 of the City of
Ridgecrest is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 201 RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Street rights-of-way, paving, curbs, gutters, and
sidewalks, planting strips, street signs, stubbed
street barriers, and street lighting shall be pro-
vided in conformance with the minimum standards
prescribed in this section and in Table 1, and shall
be constructed to the standard specifications for
construction as adopted by the City Council and on
record at the time of Planning Commission approval
of the tentative map.

Stubbed street barriers shall be erected in the one
(1) foot reserve strip at the dead end of a stubbed
street unless deleted by the Planning Commission.

Street lights shall be installed on ornamental con-
crete or steel electroliers of a type available
from the utility company or of a design approved by
the utility company and the City Engineer. Electro-
lier spacing shall be a maximum of 200 feet and each
light shall have a minimum intensity of 7,000 lumens
except that electrolier spacing on a major street
shall be a maximum of 225 feet and each light shall
have a minimum intensity of 11,000 lumens. The sub-
divider is encouraged to provide underground wiring
to each electrolier. Overall layout of the street
lighting system shall be as recommended by the util-
ity company and as approved by the City Engineer.

Other improvements for which no specific standards
have been adopted by the City shall be constructed
in accordance with designs approved by the City
Engineer.

No subdivision shall be recorded unless public access
is provided from the subdivision to a City, County,
State or Federally maintained road. Such public ac-
cess shall be as provided to the standards of improve-
ments set forth in the City's Standard Specifications.


2. That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.


