

ORDINANCE NO. 77-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA ESTABLISHING
TRAFFIC STOPS ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Southbound and Northbound vehicular traffic on North Norma Street shall stop at a stop sign to be erected on North Norma Street at the North and South right-of-way lines respectively of West Ward Street.

2. Southbound and Northbound vehicular traffic on South China Lake Boulevard shall stop at a stop sign to be erected on South China Lake Boulevard at the North and South right-of-way lines respectively of Upjohn Avenue.

3. Southbound and Northbound vehicular traffic on South Downs Street shall stop at a stop sign to be erected on South Downs Street at the North and South right-of-way lines respectively of West Upjohn Avenue.

4. This ordinance shall take effect as an urgency ordinance immediately upon the posting of the appropriate "Stop" signs and pavement markings at the appropriate locations as above described. The fact constituting the urgency is that the present traffic conditions at the above described locations are hazardous to the cross traffic on those streets.

5. The City Clerk shall publish this ordinance as required by law.
