

ORDINANCE NO. 81-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON TUESDAY, APRIL 13, 1982, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER TO FILL EXISTING VACANCY

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to General Law Cities in the State of California provide authority for the City Council to call a Special Municipal Election for the purpose of filling vacancies on the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest desires to consolidate such election with the Regular Municipal Election to be held in the City on the date of April 13, 1982;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby call a Special Municipal Election on April 13, 1982, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member to fill the vacancy now existing on the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest.

Section 2: That said election is to be consolidated with the Regular Municipal Election to be held in the City of Ridgecrest on such date.


