

ORDINANCE NO. 93-08

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE RIDGECREST
CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE
RIDGECREST MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT
RELATES TO CURFEW**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

The current Municipal Code has a different curfew for different age groups and for different circumstances. This ordinance establishes a single curfew for all minors.

Section 2. Amendment

Section 4-4.101 of the Ridgecrest Municipal Code is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 4-4.101 Curfew Between the Hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the Following Day.

It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to be upon the streets of the City or in places of amusement or entertainment or in other public places in said City, between the hours of 11:00 o'clock p.m. and 5:00 o'clock a.m. of the following day, unless the minor is:

(a) Accompanied by a parent, guardian or other adult person having custody or charge of said minor; or

(b) At a legitimate place of business, trade, profession or occupation at which the minor is employed; or

(c) At a public library, night class, study hall, school activity or a place of amusement, place of worship or entertainment supervised or sponsored by adult of good moral character, such as theaters, night games, recreational centers, dances and similar group activities.

(d) On the streets going directly to or returning directly from any of the places mentioned in subsections (b) and (c) hereof above."

Section 3. Repeals

Sections 4-4.102 and 4-4.103 of the Ridgecrest Municipal Code are hereby repealed.

Section 4. **Other**

Except as provided herein, the Ridgecrest Municipal Code is hereby reaffirmed and readopted.


