A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ENDORSING  
H. R. 189

WHEREAS, the transfer of certain land located at the Naval Ordnance Test Station, China Lake, California, is being considered by the United States Congress, and,

WHEREAS, H. R. 189, passed by the House of Representatives on December 17, 1963, and now before the Senate Armed Forces Committee, would accomplish this transfer and,

WHEREAS, the transfer of this land to the County of Kern for recreational, educational and other public uses would be in the best interests of the U. S. Government, Kern County and the City of Ridgecrest, and

WHEREAS, such a transfer would permit the construction of needed recreational and educational facilities on said land which would benefit the personnel of the Naval Ordnance Test Station, their dependents and the surrounding community,

THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does resolve as follows:

SECTION 1: Our representatives in Congress, and particularly senators Claire Engle and Thomas Keuchel are urged to support this legislation.


SECTION 2: The Armed Forces Committee is hereby requested to act favorably on this legislation.


