

RESOLUTION NO. 27

ADOPTING STREETS DEFICIENCY STUDY

WHEREAS, Section 2156, as amended by Chapter 1441, Statutes of 1963 Senate Bill 518 requires each city and county to transmit to the Department of Public Works on or before May 1, 1964, and each four years thereafter a report setting forth, in such detail as the Department shall require, the following:

1. The progress it has made in the construction or improvement of its street and road system;
2. An estimate of its road or street needs for the next five years;
3. A projected estimate of its road and street needs for the next ten years;
4. A map showing street and road system and deficient areas; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Council for review a map and report prepared by the Kern County Road Commissioner covering the subject Deficiency Study for the City of Ridgecrest.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain map and report are hereby approved by this Council as the Deficiency Study as per Section 2156 of the Streets and Highways Code
2. The City Administrator is directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution along with the maps and reports to the District Engineer of the Division of Highways, District IX, Bishop, for further processing by the Department.
