

RESOLUTION NO. 39

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO GRANT AN ELECTRIC FRANCHISE TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY.

WHEREAS, SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, a California corporation, has filed with the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest an application requesting that a franchise be granted to it of the character and for the purpose mentioned in the form of notice hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of said City Council the public requires that said franchise be granted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said City Council intends to grant said franchise, that hearing of objections to the granting thereof will be held at the time and place specified in the form of notice hereinafter set forth which the City Clerk of said City is hereby directed to publish at least once in the Valley Independent, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City, within fifteen (15) days after the passage of this Resolution, and that said notice shall be substantially in the following words and figures:

"NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT FRANCHISE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Southern California Edison Company, a California corporation, has filed its application with the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest requesting that said City Council grant to it a franchise for an indeterminate period, pursuant to the Franchise Act of 1937, to use and to construct and use, for transmitting and distributing electricity for any and all purposes, poles, wires, conduits and appurtenances, including communication circuits necessary or proper therefor, in, along, across,

1 upon, over and under the public streets, ways, alleys
2 and places within the City of Ridgecrest.

3 If said franchise shall be granted to it, said
4 Southern California Edison Company, its successors and
5 assigns, hereinafter designated grantee, during the
6 life of said franchise will pay to said City two per-
7 cent (2%) of the gross annual receipts of said grantee
8 arising from the use, operation or possession of
9 said franchise; provided, however, that such payment
10 shall in no event be less than one percent (1%) of
11 the gross annual receipts derived by grantee from
12 the sale of electricity within the limits of said
13 City. Such percentage shall be paid annually from
14 the date of the granting of the franchise applied
15 for, and in the event such payment shall not be made,
16 said franchise shall be forfeited.

17 The City Council of the City of Ridgecrest
18 proposes to grant said franchise for an indeterminate
19 period.

20 NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that any and all
21 persons having any objections to the granting of
22 said franchise may appear before said City Council
23 at The Las Flores School, Ridgecrest, California,
24 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., on Thursday,
25 the 2nd day of July, 1964, and be heard
26 thereon; and

27 NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that at any time
28 not later than the hour set for hearing objections,
29 any person interested may make written protest stat-
30 ing objections against the granting of said franchise,

which protest must be signed by the protestant and be delivered to the City Clerk of said City. The City Council at the time set for hearing said objections shall proceed to hear and pass upon all protests so made; and

For further particulars reference is hereby made to said application which is on file in the office of said City Clerk, and also to the resolution adopted by said City Council on the 4th day of June, 1964, declaring its intention to grant said franchise.
