FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND TO CITIES

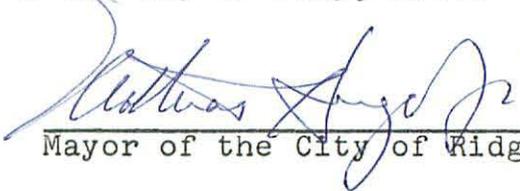

WHEREAS, the City Council has prepared a project statement showing estimated expenditures of such funds recommended to be made during the 1964-65 fiscal year; and,

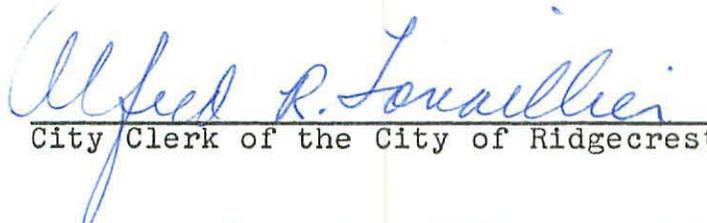
WHEREAS, the City Council has heard read said project statement and is familiar with the contents thereof;

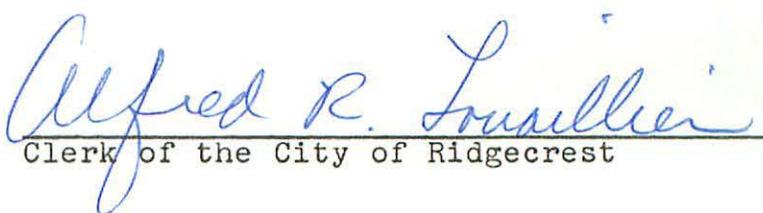
