WHEREAS, Section 8322 of the Streets and Highways Code, State of California requires that a public hearing be held.



Passed and adopted by the City Council of Ridgecrest at a regular meeting held on the 19th day of november, 1964, by the following vote:





PROPOSED VACATION OF "FUTURE ALLEY"


