

RESOLUTION NO. 115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST URGING LOCATION OF A STATE
COLLEGE IN EAST KERN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the California State Colleges are in the process of selecting a site for the Kern State College, and,

WHEREAS, among the sites offered to the Trustees are three in East Kern County; and,

WHEREAS, the Indian Wells Valley now has a population of approximately 25,000 persons the majority of whom are professionally trained and desirous of furthering their educations; and

WHEREAS, the neighboring East Kern County communities of Randsburg, Johannesburg, California City, Mojave, Rosamond and Tehachapi have an additional total population of 24,000 persons; and there are approximately 4,000 additional persons in western San Bernardino County; and,

WHEREAS, the recent incorporation of the communities of Ridgecrest and California City testify to the growing popularity of desert living and the promise of a rapidly expanding East Kern County population; and

WHEREAS, the nearest educational institution offering the variety and degree of education required by such a growing, professionally-oriented population is 150 miles away; and

WHEREAS, the educational needs of such a growing population area should not continue to be hampered by distance when a State College could be built in East Kern County; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Ridgecrest believe that a state college located within East Kern County would best serve the educational needs of the entire County population;

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Ridgecrest resolves that:


It supports and strongly urges the Trustees of the California State Colleges to select a site for the Kern State College in East Kern County.


