

RESOLUTION NO. 126

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO OPPOSE ANY CURTAILMENT OF FUNDS FROM PUBLIC LAW 815 AND PUBLIC LAW 874

WHEREAS, the majority of the students in the China Lake and Ridgecrest areas come from families employed by the Naval Ordnance Test Station, and

WHEREAS this employer does not pay property taxes, and

WHEREAS all of the students of the China Lake School District live at the Naval Ordnance Test Station in federally owned homes, and

WHEREAS, any curtailment of funds from Public Law 815 and Public Law 874 will seriously affect the standards and quality of education in the China Lake, Indian Wells Valley, and Kern Union High School Districts and put a heavy burden on the local property tax payers, now therefore be it hereby


RESOLVED that the City of Ridgecrest urge the Congress of the United States to oppose any curtailment of these funds.


