A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST APPOINTING AN EMISSARY FOR THE CITY OF RIDGECREST.

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is now an incorporated community representing 7,200 people; and

WHEREAS, the name of the City of Ridgecrest is only beginning to be widely known throughout California; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Leslie P. Norman, a resident of this area, rides horses in parades in communities throughout California; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Norman could represent the Indian Wells Valley and the City of Ridgecrest in these parades and help publicize our City;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest that:




