

RESOLUTION NO. 131

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
RIDGECREST URGING PURCHASE OF THE 106 ACRES FOR  
A REGIONAL PARK

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has authorized the transfer of certain land known as the "106 Acres" at the Naval Ordnance Test Station, China Lake, California, to the County of Kern, and

WHEREAS, this transfer of land would provide a site for a regional park, recreational facilities, and a civic center, and

WHEREAS, the need for such facilities to serve residents of China Lake, Ridgecrest, and Inyokern is great, and

WHEREAS, such a park, recreational and civic center complex would be the central focus of the Ridgecrest-China Lake community, and

WHEREAS, the planning staff of the City of Ridgecrest must know that the 106 Acres will be available for such use before it can design the General Plan around that focus, and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern has budgeted funds for the purchase of a portion of this land, and

WHEREAS, the people of the City of Ridgecrest and of the community of China Lake have demonstrated strong support for the use of this land for park, recreation, and civic center purposes,

THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does resolve as follows:


SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is urged to take immediate steps to effect the transfer of the 106 Acres at the Naval Ordnance Test Station from the U.S. Navy to the County of Kern.


