

RESOLUTION NO. 161

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST  
ON THE HEARING FOR OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS TO CHAPTER 27  
PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911

WHEREAS eighty per cent of the affected property owners on the east side of the 300 block of Alvard Street, and all of the affected property owners on both sides of the 300 block of Balsam Street have filed petitions with the City Clerk requesting the installation of curbs, gutters, and sidewalks pursuant to Chapter 27 of the Improvement Act of 1911; and

WHEREAS notice to construct and notice of hearing to pass upon objections and protests has been given in the manner and within the times required by the provisions of said Chapter 27; and

WHEREAS the hearing to pass upon objections and protests was duly held and conducted at the time and place set therefor, and no objections or protests, oral or written, were presented or made to said proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

SECTION 1. That all of the matters referred to hereinabove are found and determined to be true;

SECTION 2. That if said construction is not commenced within 60 days after notice given and diligently and without interruption prosecuted to completion, the superintendent of streets is authorized and directed to cause said construction to be done.
