A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST  
ON THE HEARINGS FOR OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS TO CHAPTER 27  
PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911

WHEREAS ninety per cent of the affected property owners on the west side of the 300 block of Alvord Street have filed petitions with the City Clerk requesting the installation of curbs, gutters, and sidewalks pursuant to Chapter 27 of the Improvement Act of 1911; and

WHEREAS notice to construct and notice of hearing to pass upon objections and protests has been given in the manner and within the times required by the provisions of said Chapter 27; and

WHEREAS the hearing to pass upon objections and protests was duly held and conducted at the time and place set therefor, and no objections or protests, oral or written, were presented or made to said proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

SECTION 1. That all of the matters referred to hereinabove are found and determined to be true;



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM  
ON THE BEARING FOR DELIVERY OF WATER TO CERTAIN  
PROPERTIES UNDER THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911

WHEREAS ninety per cent of the affected property owners on the  
west side of the 300 block of Alford Street have filed petitions  
with the City Clerk requesting the installation of water, gas, sewer  
and electric lines pursuant to Chapter 17 of the Improvement Act of 1911  
and

WHEREAS notice to construct and notice of hearing to pass upon  
objections and plans has been given in the manner and within the  
times required by the provisions of said Chapter 17, and

WHEREAS the hearing to pass upon objections and protests has  
only been held at the time and place and in the manner and  
manner of procedure, and all objections were presented and made to  
said proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM  
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

SECTION 1. That all of the matters referred to hereinabove  
are legal and determined to be such;

SECTION 2. That it is the policy of the City of Birmingham  
to give water to all property and that the water  
service to be completed, the improvement of streets is water-  
and electric lines and gas lines shall be done.
