RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF RIDGECREST  
ADOPTING AND SUBMITTING A BUDGET FOR EXPENDITURE OF  
FUNDS ALLOCATED FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND TO CITIES

WHEREAS, the city council has prepared a project statement showing estimated expenditures of such funds recommended to be made during the 1967-68 fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the city council has heard read said project statement and is familiar with the contents thereof;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the city council of the City of Ridgecrest that said project statement dated January 26, 1967, be and is hereby adopted as the budget of proposed expenditures of the gas tax allocation to cities, said project statement be and the same is hereby approved and the Mayor is directed to sign


