A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST COMMENDING  
THE RIDGECREST LITTLE LEAGUE

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Little League has completed construction of the first phase of its new ball park on South Downs Street, and

WHEREAS, this ball park is to be dedicated at 5:30 p.m. Friday May 12, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the completion of this phase of the Little League ball park is a triumph for the officers, directors, managers, and coaches of the Ridgecrest Little League, and

WHEREAS, this ball park is a tribute to the spirit of community cooperation prevailing in the Ridgecrest-China Lake community, and

WHEREAS, the completion at this phase of the ball park would not have been possible without the hard manual labor, dedication, and enthusiasm of the adult officials of the Ridgecrest Little League and without the cooperation of the community,
