

RESOLUTION NO. 191

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF RIDGECREST URGING SENATOR STIERN AND  
ASSEMBLYMAN STACY TO SUPPORT AB 2454

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2454 in the Legislature of the State of California vitally affects this City's street construction program, and

WHEREAS, AB 2454 would make additional gas tax funds available to this City for street construction by eliminating much of the present gas tax administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, AB 2454 will accomplish this reduction in paperwork costs by eliminating the matching requirements of the 1963 Collier-Unruh Act and by eliminating the need for Division of Highways approval of budgets, plans, and specifications, and

WHEREAS, the detailed administrative and legal limitations on the use of gas tax funds will be abolished by AB 2454, and

WHEREAS, the State will save thousands of dollars in administrative costs by adopting AB 2454, and

WHEREAS, the State Controller's office under AB 2454 would continue to have sufficient controls over the legality of gas tax fund expenditures by cities to insure compliance with the intent of the Select Street System construction program of the 1963 Act,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest resolves as follows:

That Senator Walter W. Stiern and Assemblyman Kent H. Stacy are urged to support AB 2454 and to lend their influence to insure passage of this important street construction measure.


