

RESOLUTION NO. 204

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST REQUESTING CALIFORNIA DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS TO SEEK NAVY DEDICATION FOR WIDENING NORTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD AND EAST RIDGECREST BOULEVARD

WHEREAS there is an increasing number of accidents along North China Lake Boulevard, from Inyokern Road to Ridgecrest Boulevard, and along East Ridgecrest Boulevard, from China Lake Boulevard to the County Line; and

WHEREAS the local Navy command has expressed its willingness to recommend dedication of the necessary land for widening such highways to the appropriate agencies; and

WHEREAS the General Plan of the City of Ridgecrest contemplates the widening of such highways with the installation of a green strip or buffer strip along the Navy property;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


