

RESOLUTION NO. 208

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST URGING CITIZEN SUPPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PROGRAM TO END DISCRIMINATION IN OFF-BASE HOUSING FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Defense has requested that all communities, especially those adjacent to military installations, join with him and assist in every possible way the efforts of the Defense Department in securing equal opportunity in obtaining off-Base rental housing for military personnel; and

WHEREAS, the members of this Council do unanimously pledge their support of this program to create a nondiscriminatory housing policy atmosphere and urge that all citizens of the City adopt and pursue the same attitude.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST resolves:


