

RESOLUTION NO. 211

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST ON THE HEARING FOR
OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS TO CHAPTER 27
PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE IMPROVEMENT ACT
OF 1911

WHEREAS, petitions have been filed with the City Clerk representing the signatures of the owners of more than sixty (60) per cent of the front footage in the following blocks for the installation of the following improvements pursuant to Chapter 27 of the Improvement Act of 1911; and

74 %	East side, 300 block of North Norma Street	Curbs, gutters, and sidewalks
68.33 %	West side, 300 block of North Norma Street	Curbs, gutters, and sidewalks
100 %	South side, 300 block of East Church Street	Sidewalks only
70 %	East side, 200 block of Silver Ridge Drive	Curbs, gutters, and sidewalks
61 %	West side, 200 block of Silver Ridge Drive	Curbs, gutters, and sidewalks

WHEREAS, notice to construct and notice of hearing to pass upon objections and protests has been given in the manner and within the times required by provisions of said Chapter 27; and

WHEREAS, the hearing to pass upon objections and protests was duly held and conducted at the time and place set therefor, and no objections or protests, oral or written, were presented or made to said proceedings, or such objections as were presented were overruled;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. That all of the matters referred to hereinabove are found and determined to be true;

Section 2. That if said construction is not commenced within sixty (60) days after notice given and is not diligently and without interruption prosecuted to completion, the Superintendent of


Streets is authorized and directed to cause said construction to be done.



