

Resolution No. 212

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AMENDING THE  
CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR CITY EMPLOYEE  
POSITIONS

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Resolution No. 169, the Classification Plan for City Employee positions, requires that this plan be amended when a new position is created; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to create the position of Light Equipment Operator;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That the Position Classification Plan is hereby amended to add the position of Light Equipment Operator.

2. That the classification specification for the position of Light Equipment Operator is added to and made a part of the Position Classification Plan.

Class Specification

LIGHT EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

DEFINITION

Under supervision of Street Maintenance Foreman, operates dump truck, skiploader, tractor hauling roller or road-mix trailers, water truck, street sweeper, or other light street maintenance equipment in excavating, resurfacing, paving, or sweeping streets; performs other street maintenance tasks as assigned.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES (Illustrative Only)

Operates street sweeping vehicle to sweep City streets daily or as necessary to remove sand and debris from City streets; dumps sweepings in assigned location; performs sweeper vehicle maintenance as necessary;

Operates skiploader to load road paving materials into dump truck; operates skiploader to load waste road paving materials or sand into dump truck;

Drives dump truck to and from road materials mixing site and paving sites and from paving sites to waste road materials dumping site; may haul gravel from quarry to road mix site; operates dump body lift;

Operates tractor to haul road-mixer trailer or rubber-tired roller, may operate self-propelled roller, in repaving or resurfacing streets; may operate water truck to spray water on dirt street surface to reduce dust or to prepare soil for compaction;

Performs light maintenance tasks on street equipment such as oiling, washing, greasing, fueling, or minor repairs;

Performs wide variety of other street maintenance tasks as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

Operation of dump truck, skiploader, street sweeper, and other street maintenance equipment; and

Ability to:

Operate street sweeper, dump truck, skiploader, tractor, and other street maintenance equipment;

Operate such equipment and perform manual labor tasks as assigned in desert heat;  
Maintain and make minor repairs on street sweeper;  
Follow oral and written instructions and simple job diagrams; and

License:

California Driver's License; and

Education:

Completion of the fifth grade; and

Experience:

One year of experience operating dump truck, skiploader, and other light equipment, and six months experience operating street sweeper (may be concurrent with above experience).
