

RESOLUTION NO. 213

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST SUPPORTING ASSEMBLY
JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 29 OF THE CALIFORNIA
LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has adopted Assembly Joint Resolution No. 29; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest strongly supports the concept of the Federal Government sharing its' tax revenues with state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the nature of urban problems requires direct solution by state and local governments of these problems; and

WHEREAS; the California Legislature, in Assembly Joint Resolution No. 29, urges the Congress of the United States to enact a workable and realistic tax-sharing program;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest supports the intent of Assembly Joint Resolution No. 29.

2. That the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest urges serious Congressional consideration of a tax-sharing program.


