

RESOLUTION NO. 215

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST URGING THE KERN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ENTER A JOINT EXERCISE OF POWERS AGREEMENT TO BUILD A MUNICIPAL POOL, RECREATION CENTER, CIVIC CENTER, AND OTHER PUBLIC BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest wishes to provide the citizens of Ridgecrest with a municipal pool and recreation center at the Henry D. Hellmers Park, and a civic center and other public buildings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does not wish to levy a property tax to pay for the construction of these public improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest will have sufficient revenue from cigarette and transient occupancy taxes to pay for these facilities on a lease-purchase basis; and

WHEREAS, Article 1 (commencing with Section 6500), Chapter 5, Division 7, Title 1, of the Government Code of the State of California, provides that, by authorization of their legislative bodies, two or more public agencies by agreement may jointly exercise any power common to the contracting parties; and

WHEREAS, Article 2 (Section 6546), Chapter 5, Division 7, Title 1, of the Government Code of the State of California, provides that any agency, commission, or board provided for by a joint powers agreement pursuant to Article 1 may issue revenue bonds to pay the cost and expenses of acquiring or constructing a public building, facility, or structure which the contracting parties have the power by law to construct; and

WHEREAS, under a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement the City and the County can form a Public Building Authority to construct public buildings, lease them to the City, and issue revenue bonds against the lease to pay for the construction, all at no cost to the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is urged to enter into a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement with the City of Ridgecrest to construct a municipal pool, a recreation center, a civic center, and other public buildings.

Section 2. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern is urged to authorize the County Counsel to consult with the City Attorney on a draft of the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for this purpose.

Section 3. That the City Attorney is instructed to confer with the County Counsel and representatives of the firms of Stone and Youngberg and O'Melveny and Myers on a draft of a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for this purpose.
