A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ACCEPTING OFFER
OF DEDICATION OF CERTAIN STREETS AND
RIGHTS OF WAY IN TRACT 1624

WHEREAS a final map for Tract 1624 was approved on February 11, 1952, by the Kern County Board of Supervisors, and recorded on February 15, 1952, in the Kern County Recorder's Office in Book 7 of Maps, Page 192; and

WHEREAS at the time of said approval certain streets, paths, alleys, storm drainage easements or other rights of way offered for dedication thereon were not accepted; and

WHEREAS such offers of dedication have never been terminated and abandoned in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS it is desired to rescind the previous action of non-acceptance or rejection, and to accept certain streets, paths, alleys, storm drainage easements or other rights of way set forth hereinafter, pursuant to California Business and Professions Code Section 11616;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the rejection of the offers of dedication of those certain streets, paths, alleys, storm drainage easements or other rights of way described hereinafter is herewith rescinded, and said offers are accepted.

2. That upon construction of all necessary improvements, such streets, paths, alleys, storm drainage easements or other rights of way shall be opened for public use.

3. That those streets, paths, alleys, storm drainage easements or other rights of way which are the subject of this resolution and which are referred to herein are described as follows:

PARCEL NO. 1 - All that portion of land in Lot 20 of Tract 1624 as recorded in Map Book 7, Page 192, Kern County Recorder's Office, lying between the South line of said Lot 20, also being the Westerly extension of the centerline of Argus Street and the future street line as shown on the map of said tract.


