

RESOLUTION NO. 221

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR TEMPORARY CLOSING OF CITY STREETS WHICH ARE ALSO STATE HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS the City of Ridgecrest desires from time to time, for the safety and protection of the public, to temporarily close various city streets, or portions thereof, which are also State highways, for celebrations, parades, local special events and other purposes, as provided in California Vehicle Code Section 21101(f); and

WHEREAS the City desires to have such procedure approved by the State Department of Public Works, as provided in California Vehicle Code Section 21104 and Section 26.24 of the State Maintenance Manual;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That whenever the City of Ridgecrest desires to temporarily close city streets or portions thereof which are also State highways in order to provide for the safety and protection of the public during celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes, the following procedure shall be followed:

a. Written application shall be forwarded to the District Engineer in charge, Division of Highways, State Department of Public Works, setting forth all relevant information pertaining to the desired temporary closing of streets, including the proposed dates and times of closing, description of streets or portions thereof desired to be closed, suitable detour(s), provisions for local regulation of traffic during such periods, and such other matters as may be requested by the State Department of Public Works from time to time.

b. Upon receipt of the approved application, copies thereof will be forwarded to the Offices of the District Engineer and the California Highway Patrol in charge of the area.

2. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21104, a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the California Department of Public Works for approval prior to the enactment hereof being effective as to any state highway or part thereof specified in the written approval of such department.
