

RESOLUTION NO. 223

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.
86 REGARDING STANDARD STREET NAME SIGNS AS
SHOWN IN THE "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS"

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest in Resolution No. 86 adopted "Standard Specifications" governing construction on public property, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest wishes to amend said Resolution to change the Standard Specification for street name signs,


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That Standard Specification No. S-11 shall be amended to provide that street name signs shall be of the following specifications:
 - a. Metal: .080 gauge aluminum, 6061T6 alloy.
 - b. Size: Six inches high; varying length
 - c. Plate: Single, flat plate prepared with degreasing and Alodine 1200 treatment, double faced
 - d. Background for Legend:
 - (1) Color: Blue
 - (2) Material: Reflective film
 - e. Legend:
 - (1) Color: Golden Yellow, 575-590 millimicrons
 - (2) Size: 4-inch-high letters in street name
2-inch-high block numbers underneath
2-inch-high street type ("AVE", "ST",
"RD", etc.)
 - (3) Material: Reflective film
 - f. Hardware:
 - (1) Cap to fit 2" ID pipe with Allenhead set screws
 - (2) 90° or 45° center cross bracket, as specified by Superintendent of Streets


- (3) Phillips washer face machine screws to hold plates
 - (4) 2-inch-ID standard galvanized pipe
 - g. Mounting height from finished grade:
 - (1) 7' 0" minimum to bottom of lowest street name sign
 - (2) 8' 6" to bottom of lowest street name sign when combined with 30" stop sign
 - h. Stop sign will be mounted on same post when required at same corner, six (6) feet above finished grade to bottom of stop sign
 - i. Base:
 - (1) Minimum of 2' 0" pipe below finished grade
 - (2) 14" diameter portland cement around pipe
 - (3) Below grade depth of concrete base minimum 4" to top, 23" to bottom
 - (4) Topped by 12" square formed top, troweled and tooled, finished to match sidewalk, 4 inches deep
 - (5) Minimum 3 inches from bottom of pipe to bottom of concrete base
 - j. Location at intersection: To be determined by Superintendent of Streets
2. That the Superintendent of Streets is hereby instructed to prepare a graphic portrayal of these specifications for inclusion in the Standard Specifications.
3. That these specifications be adopted as minimum standards to be exceeded in new subdivisions by approval of the Planning Commission and City Council.
