

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST SUPPORTING FEDERAL AND STATE
LAWS FOR FAIR HOUSING AND URGING CITIZENS
OF RIDGECREST TO HELP ACHIEVE OBJECTIVES
THEREOF

WHEREAS the Congress of the United States has proclaimed that it is the policy of the United States to provide, within constitutional limitations, for fair housing throughout the United States, and pursuant to said policy enacted the Fair Housing Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS the State of California has declared the practice of discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, or ancestry in housing accommodations to be against public policy, and has enacted the Rumford Act to implement said policy; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest to actively support said policies and laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST:

1. That the letter and spirit of the Federal Fair Housing Act of 1968 and the State Rumford Act, enacted to implement a policy of fair and nondiscriminatory rights to housing accommodations by all persons irrespective of race, color, religion, national origin, or ancestry, are herewith endorsed and supported.


