RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST ON HEARING FOR OBJECTIONS OR PROTESTS
TO CHAPTER 27 PROCEEDINGS UNDER IMPROVEMENT ACT
OF 1911

WHEREAS, pursuant to petitions received for the installation of curbs, gutters and sidewalks pursuant to Chapter 27 of the Improvement Act of 1911, proceedings have been initiated for the construction of said improvements; and

WHEREAS, notice to construct and notice of hearing to pass upon objections or protests have been given in the manner and within the times required by the provisions of said Chapter 27; and

WHEREAS, the hearing to pass upon objections or protests was duly held and conducted at the time and place set therefor, and all persons desiring to be heard were given such opportunity, and all questions, comments, objections or protests, oral or written, were duly considered;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

1. That all of the matters referred to hereinabove are found and determined to be true and correct.
2. That all protests and objections are overruled and it is determined that public convenience and necessity require the installation of such improvements at locations described and set forth in Resolution No. 340.
3. That if construction is not commenced within 60 days after notice given and diligently and without interruption prosecuted to completion, the superintendent of streets is authorized and directed to cause said construction to be done, and the cost of the same shall be a lien on the property.
4. That pursuant to Resolution No. 340, bonds shall be issued and assessments collected and enforced as set forth therein on all unpaid assessments.
