

RESOLUTION NO. 350

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING PRE-
VAILING RATES OF WAGES FOR LEGAL, HOLIDAY
AND OVERTIME WORK IN SAID CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 1770 et seq. of the Cali-
fornia Labor Code, the City Council desires to determine, as-
certain and fix the general prevailing rates of wages for legal,
holiday and overtime work in said locality for each craft, clas-
sification or type of workman for which a public contract may
be let;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
RESOLVES, DETERMINES AND ORDERS:

1. That the general prevailing rates of wages and employer
payments for health, welfare, vacation and pension applicable to
the work to be done in the City of Ridgecrest is shown in Exhibit
"A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

2. That any classification omitted herein shall be paid not
less than \$2.50 per hour, plus employer payments set forth in the
collective bargaining agreement applicable to the class or classi-
fication of workman involved, as defined in Section 1773.1 of the
California Labor Code.


3. That overtime shall be paid at not less than one and
one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) times the above scheduled rates, and Sundays and
Holidays shall be paid not less than one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) times
the above scheduled rates. The holidays upon which such rates
shall be paid shall be all holidays recognized in the collective
bargaining agreement applicable to the particular craft, classi-
fication or type of workmen employed on the project.



EXHIBIT "A"

GENERAL PREVAILING RATE OF PER DIEM WAGES

CEMENT MASONS

Health & Welfare - 80¢
 Pension - 85¢
 Vacation - 60¢
 Apprenticeship - 2¼¢

Per Diem: \$12 per day
 Travel Time: None

Foreman: When three or more Cement Masons are employed on a job, one shall be employed as a Foreman and shall receive not less than 60¢ per hour more than the hourly rate of the highest Cement Mason classification over which he has responsibility.

Cement Mason Journeyman: including but not restricted to the following: Chipping, patching; setting curb form and plank, setting of lines, stakes and grades; setting screed, which includes screed pins; cutting, scoring and sawing new concrete; plugging, filling, Shee-Bolt holes; dry packing concrete and Embco; tending material hose on slabs, floors and decks; tending mixer-truck chute, slabs, floors and decks; bush hammering; patching and sacking; rodding, tamping, bit well rodding, machine and similar types, bull floating.
