

RESOLUTION NO. 356

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 123 TO LENGTHEN THE PROBATIONARY PERIOD FOR ALL CLASSES OF POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 9 of Ordinance No. 54 and Rule X, Section 1, of Resolution No. 123 requires a probationary period for all original and promotional personnel appointments of not less than six months of actual service; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Rule X, Resolution No. 123, states that the City Council may, by resolution, establish a longer probationary period for specified classes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a longer probationary period is required for all classes of positions in order to properly evaluate the performance of probationary employees prior to appointment to permanent status;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the probationary period for original and promotional appointments to all classes of positions in the Competitive Service shall be not less than one year of actual service.


Section 2. That this Resolution shall apply to all original and promotional appointments made on or after the date of adoption of this Resolution.


