

RESOLUTION NO. 361

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT TO CHARGE ADDITIONAL FEES FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTIONS AFTER REGULAR OFFICE HOURS.

WHEREAS, contractors frequently perform construction tasks requiring building inspections after regular office hours of the Building Inspection Department including nights, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays; and

WHEREAS, such inspections require additional expense on the part of the City and considerable inconvenience to inspectors; and

WHEREAS, the present office hours of the Building Inspection Department, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, are inconvenient to contractors who frequently perform construction tasks on Saturdays and less frequently construct at night, on holidays, and on Sundays;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:


1. That the Building Inspection Department is authorized and instructed to increase its inspection time by providing an inspector for Saturday morning inspections at no additional charge to contractors, provided that requests for Saturday inspection are made before Friday noon.

2. That the Building Inspection Department is authorized to charge fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour for inspections after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, or after noon on Saturdays, or on Sundays, or on City holidays, when such inspections are requested with a minimum of 24 hours notice to the Department.

3. That the Building Inspection Department is authorized to charge fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour for inspections after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, or after noon on Saturdays, or on Sundays, or on City holidays, when contractors are found by the Department to be constructing without requesting required inspections during said hours in violation of City building codes.
