

RESOLUTION NO. 363

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, REQUIRING THE CHARGING OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE OF FIFTY PERCENT FOR WORK PERFORMED BY THE STREET MAINTENANCE CREW FOR PRIVATE PARTIES.

WHEREAS, the Street Maintenance Department is frequently requested to patch holes on private property and to install signs in new subdivisions in lieu of having private enterprise perform such work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is reluctant to compete with private enterprise except where private enterprise is unable to perform said services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide said services in lieu of private enterprise where private enterprise cannot perform said work and citizens of this city are thereby inconvenienced;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Street Maintenance Department shall not perform such work without the approval of the City Administrator.

Section 2. That the Street Maintenance Department shall keep an accurate record of its labor and equipment time and amount of materials on each such private work and shall report said time and materials amounts to the City Clerk's office.


Section 3. The City Clerk is instructed to calculate the actual labor, materials and equipment costs for said work and is instructed to add to an invoice for such work 50% of the above costs as an administrative charge.


