

RESOLUTION NO. 367

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST DIRECTING WORK TO BE DONE IN
PROCEEDING UNDER CHAPTER 27, CALIFORNIA
STREETS & HIGHWAYS CODE
(West Side, 300 Block, S. Gordon St. (Surber St.))

WHEREAS, all of the property owners affected have presented to the City Council and the City Clerk their signed petition requesting the installation of curbs, gutters and paving on the West side of the 300 block of S. Gordon Street (Surber Street) between West Church Avenue and 530 feet north of West Upjohn Road; and

WHEREAS, said petition was presented pursuant to Chapter 27, Part 3, Division 7, California Streets & Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, the property owners waived the right to a hearing and the sixty-day waiting period provided by Streets & Highways Code Sections 5878.1 and 5879, and requested immediate installation of said improvements at the same time as improvements of S. Gordon Street (Surber Street) are being made in connection with an adjoining subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the property owners did not waive their right to a hearing on the assessment of costs of construction under Section 5881;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. All matters set forth hereinabove are found and determined to be true and correct.
2. All affected property owners having by petition waived their right to a hearing and the sixty-day waiting period required by California Streets & Highways Code Sections 5878.1 and 5879, all notices otherwise required by law are dispensed with.
3. The Superintendent of Streets is authorized and directed to immediately cause the construction to be done, with the cost of the same to be a lien upon the property of the affected owners.
4. Upon completion of construction, all notices, hearings and other matters required by California Streets and Highways Code Sections 5881 et seq. shall be given, held and otherwise complied with.
