

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, MAKING
APPLICATION FOR MERGER OF RIDGECREST
SANITATION DISTRICT WITH THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST

WHEREAS, the Kern County Local Agency Formation Commission has recommended that the Ridgecrest Sanitation District be merged with the City of Ridgecrest; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator, who is also Secretary of the Ridgecrest Sanitation District, and the City Engineer, who is also Engineer-Manager of the Ridgecrest Sanitation District, have reviewed such recommendation and filed their report, dated December 21, 1971, approving and concurring in such recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Ridgecrest Sanitation District have approved such merger and consented to the commencement and initiation of proceedings to accomplish the merger; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has reviewed and considered the recommendations and report referred to hereinabove, and desires to initiate proceedings to effect such merger;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREBY RESOLVES, FINDS AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City of Ridgecrest hereby makes application pursuant to Section 56195 of Division 1 of Title 6 of the Government Code of the State of California.
2. The nature of the proposed change of organization is the merger of the Ridgecrest Sanitation District with the City of Ridgecrest.
3. Proposed terms and conditions to which the proposed merger is desired to be subject, in addition to those imposed and established by law, include the following: (a) All areas in the City not presently within the boundaries of the District shall be subject to taxes for payment of all principal, interest and other charges for general obligation bonds of the District; (b) All areas in the City not presently within the boundaries of the District, and not presently receiving sewage service from the District, will be required to pay the Off-Site Facilities Charge specified in District Ordinance No. 70-2 in order to receive sewage service.

4. The reasons for the proposal include the following: The entire territory of the Ridgecrest Sanitation District is within the corporate boundaries of the City of Ridgecrest; the City of Ridgecrest possesses legal authority to perform all of the functions vested in the Ridgecrest Sanitation District; the legislative body of the District is composed of the same individuals as the council of the City; the merger has been recommended by the Kern County Local Agency Formation Commission.



5. Request is hereby made that proceedings be taken for the merger proposed herein.


