

RESOLUTION NO. 383

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING  
GRANT DEED FOR PORTION OF EAST RIDGECREST  
BLVD. RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, John S. Griffith and Company, a California corporation, have offered for dedication a portion of East Ridgecrest Boulevard for right of way purposes, legally described as:

Being a portion of the Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Section 34, Township 26 South, Range 40 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Being also a portion of the Naval Ordinance Test Station as shown by Record of Survey Map recorded March 19, 1945 in Book 5, Pages 26 to 30 of Record of Survey Maps in the office of the Kern County Recorder, State of California, described as follows:

A strip of land 20.00 feet in width bounded on the north by a line parallel with and 50.00 feet north of the south line of said Section; bounded on the South by a line parallel with and 30.00 feet north of the south line of said Section; bounded on the east by west property line of Desert Park Housing Area as recorded in Book 2361, Page 437 of Official Records of said County; bounded on the west by the north-easterly line of an easement to the State of California as recorded in Book 4263, page 213 of Official Records of said County.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council hereby accepts for public right of way purposes that real property and/or interest and/or easement described in that Grant Deed dated January 24, 1972, and signed by William C. Brown as President and James G. Degnan as Secretary on behalf of John S. Griffith & Co., a California corporation.
2. That the City Council hereby consents to the recordation of the above described Grant Deed and authorize the Mayor to sign a Certificate of Acceptance of it.


