

RESOLUTION NO. 406

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA,  
REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF KERN TO  
SHARE THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING  
RESTROOMS IN THE RIDGECREST PARK

WHEREAS, The County of Kern Parks and Recreation Department has closed the condemned permanent restroom building at the Ridgcrest Park; and

WHEREAS, The County Parks and Recreation Department provides inadequate and frequently unusable chemical toilets in lieu of permanent restroom facilities at Ridgcrest Park; and

WHEREAS, These temporary toilets are frequently not properly maintained and constitute a public health hazard; and

WHEREAS, These temporary toilets are costing the County of Kern thirty dollars per month in rental fees; and

WHEREAS, Citizens of the County of Kern continually complain about this unsatisfactory restroom arrangement and many will not use the park because of it;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. The County of Kern Board of Supervisors is requested to share with the City of Ridgcrest fifty per cent of the cost of constructing adequate, relatively vandal-proof, permanent restroom facilities at the Ridgcrest Park.


2. The City Clerk is instructed to forward copies of this Resolution to the Board of Supervisors and the Parks and Recreation Dept. of the County of Kern.
