

RESOLUTION NO. 409

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 86 TO PROVIDE
MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR AGGREGATE
USED IN CONSTRUCTION OF STREET
IMPROVEMENTS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

That Resolution No. 86 of the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

WHEREAS, Ordinances 79, 80, and 128 require public property and street improvements to be constructed in accordance with Standard Specifications adopted by the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:


1. The "Standard Specifications", a copy of which is attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof by reference, is hereby adopted as the Standard Specifications of the City of Ridgecrest governing construction on public property and streets.
2. Each of the specifications in the Standard Specifications of the City which refer to use of concrete in said construction is hereby amended to provide that the aggregate in such concrete shall conform to the requirements set forth in Sections 90-2.02 through 90-3.04 of the Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, January, 1971, edition.
3. Copies of the Standard Specifications of the City shall be made available to the public at the local office of the City Engineer and may be purchased for the sum of \$2.50 per copy.
